## Youth Organization Celebrated Worlds Teachers day on 5<sup>th</sup> October at Government Boys High School Maizi Adda District Killa Abdullah.

Youth organization in collaboration with Pakistan Collation for Education (PCE) and Education Department organized the World Teacher's Day on 05<sup>th</sup> October 2021 at Government Boys High School Maizi Adda district Killa Abdullah. In the event, 100 participants included the teachers from primary, middle, high schools, students, members of parents and teacher committee, district administration, education department, media, civil society organizations representatives, and other stockholders from the community. The main objectives of the activity were to conduct discussion between teachers, school authorities, and the education department for effective planning for school safety and developing teaching practices to mitigate post-pandemic learning loss and also present 10 recommendations to the education department on how to make schools safe for children, teachers, and the school staff, how to ensure access to digital/online education for all, and what teachers required capacities require after the pandemic.



World Teachers' Day is held annually on 5<sup>th</sup> October 2021 to celebrate all teachers around the globe. This day is observed to recognize the rights and responsibilities of teachers and to focus on appreciating, accessing, and improving the educators of the world. The

theme of World Teachers' Day 2021 is 'Teachers at the heart of education recovery'. It aims to recognize the tireless efforts of teachers to keep lessons going and ensure minimal disruption to pupils' learning throughout the pandemic.

It is also known as International Teachers' Day. It aims to raise awareness about the role of teachers in playing quality education at all levels and to improve the situations of teachers in the world. The day commemorates the anniversary of the adoption of the 1966 ILO/UNESCO Recommendation concerning the Status of Teachers. It sets benchmarks about the rights and responsibilities of teachers and standards for their initial preparation.

The day honor educator's associations around the world. It was created by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) not only to show appreciation for teachers all over the world but also to assess the day and help teachers to improve. Its main aim is to prepare instructors and to guarantee that the requirements of future ages will keep on being met by educators.



The theme of World Teachers' Day 2021 is "Teachers at the heart of education recovery". As per UNESCO, "a five-day series of global and regional events will showcase

the effect that the pandemic has had on the teaching profession, highlight effective and promising policy responses, and aim to establish the steps that need to be taken to ensure that teaching personnel develops their full potential."

World Teacher's Day was commenced with the Holy Recitation of the Quran by Mr. Abdul Qadeer, the event started with the formal introduction of the participants and all the participants were formally welcomed. Details of the proceedings (discussion and decisions made) are as follows:

After the recitation of the Holy Quran, Mr. Hameedullah Kakar Executive Director of Youth Organization shared the objectives of World Teacher's Day. During the activity the academia, social activists, Director Education and local organizations, students, parents' teacher's committee members, and professionals participated in the event and also shared their valuable comments regarding the event and the importance of education. Later on, formally all the preplanned sessions were carried out with due timing.



Mr. Abdul Wahid Shakir Baloch Director of Education shared the importance of education in our society. He says that education is playing a vital role in society we should give importance to education. He also encourage teachers to perform their duties with honesty and said our priority should be education and increase the enrollment of students and must follow the safety precaution of COVID-19 and NCOC SoPs during the classes and also ensure the implementation of SoPs in the schools. He

shared that during the COVID-19 pandemic our education system is badly affected now it's time to cover the gap to continue education smoothly. He also said that online education should be a part of education in this situation, he gives directions to DDO Killa Abdullah to maintain the digital system in schools provide essential kits to teachers, and ensure the SoPs.

Mr. Kaleem Shah regional director education department of the Government of Balochistan gives his overview about the government interventions and improvement of government strategies towards the increase of education ratio in Balochistan with approved SoPs of NCOC and provincial task force. He also appreciated the efforts of PCE and other civil society regarding the celebration of international teacher's day, he urged and demanded lawmakers to properly implement the policies that they can eradicate illiteracy and drop out ratio from the province making fruitful and applicable policies.

Mr. Amin Ullah DDO Education Killa Abdullah shared the importance of education and also briefly discussed the education status in this COVID-19 situation and SoPs. He shared that the government is working to ensure free and compulsory education, 25A to increase the ratio of education in Balochistan and especially in Killa Abdullah.



Mr. Abdul Qadeer the provincial coordinator told about the current status of drop-out children from the schools in Balochistan due to the COVID-19 situation. He told that due to lack of laws and their proper implementation the huge ratio of children leaving the schools because their parents cannot offer their

educational expense and major reason of drop out is corporal punishment in the educational institute government should approve the corporal punishment bill as soon as possible that we can control the drop out ratio.

Mr. Raheed Shah Executive Director of SMAAJ organization give orientation on the importance of education and International Teacher's Day for the education he also appreciated the efforts of the education department for the improvement of literacy ratio and emphasizes to the government education departments and all political parties to make sure the proper implication of all approved laws regarding the free and compulsory education.



Mr. Abdul Nafea Head Master Government Boys High School Armbi Masazai shared the details about education he says that Education can be formal and informal. Formal education generally has a standard and structured curriculum. School and university education is an excellent form of formal education. Informal education includes informal learning and skills acquired without any structured curriculum. Any experience that bears a positive impact on a person can also be considered educational. He also told us the importance of making sure the precautions to protect from the COVID-19 and ensure the SoPs that we can our self and children protection from the COVID-19 pandemic.



Mr. Izzat Ullah headmaster of government high school Masazai WFP briefly describes education and its importance he says that the pursuit of education is one of the most crucial aspects of life. Education is what empowers us. It gives us the knowledge of the world and allows us to experience life in all its wonderful colors. One cannot truly enjoy living without knowing the wonders surrounding it, to just live is not actually living and only enlightenment makes one feel alive. Education is what differentiates man from animals. It teaches us how to socialize and most importantly it humanizes us. Due to our learning, we can engage and interact with our environment. All the rich resources found in nature would be of no use to humanity if there was no enlightenment on how to utilize them. He also emphasizes to the government to properly implement the 25A and also requested to keep continue the delivery of education through the provided SoPs.

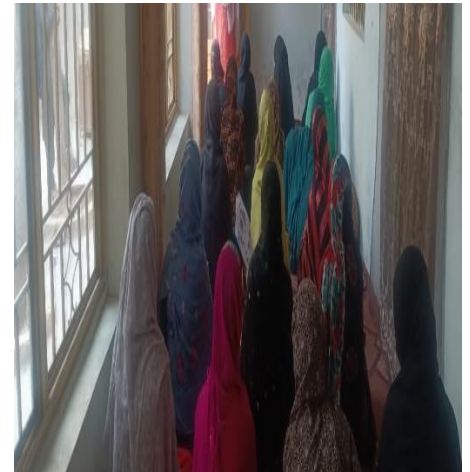

## Women Workers Alliance District Convention at Girls Elementary College Pishin.

The Women Workers District Convention was conducted on 5th July 2021 at Girls Elementary College Pishin in which 72 women workers and 6 officials participated the district convention. The Member of the National Assembly Mr. Muli Kamal- Ud-Din was the chief guest of the event. The main purpose of the convention was to demand administrative improvements for better labor governance at all levels. The women workers district convention formally started with the recitation of the Holy Quran by Ms. Sadaf after the recitation the executive director Youth Organization Mr. Hameedullah Kakar presented the welcome to the chief guest and all participants for joining the district level convention after the welcome note the project coordinator Mr. Syed Jaffer Ali shared the objectives of the convention and give the detailed presentation about EWAM project, Youth Organization interventions and TDEA for the better understanding of guests speakers and participants.



After that, the women workers alliance members Ms. Nargis, Hina Noor, Bushra Amjad, and Zamzama presented the charter of demand in front of the chief guest, guest speakers, labor department, and participants

for further legislation and advocacy. The alliance members urged the MNA to present our demands in the national assembly and provincial assembly through their party MPAs for further legislation and bound the labor department to work on these demands for the betterment of workplaces for the women workers. The alliance members also urged the media persons to give better coverage and highlight the presented charter of demand in newspapers for advocacy and awareness-raising.

Ms. Alia Nazir District Election Commissioner Pishin appreciated the efforts of TDEA, Youth Organization, and Women Workers Alliance Members for the empowerment of women workers in district Pishin, she shared that my support will be available at any time and I appreciate the efforts of the Youth Organization which are working in district Pishin for the empowerment of women especially in the voter education and provision of CNIC and she also ensure her support on behalf of election commission at any time.



The labor inspector Mr. Sami Ullah shared that we are closely working with Youth Organization for providing a friendly atmosphere to women workers in district Pishin, he shared that we are also working on shared monitoring reports of Youth Organization women workers alliance members of each workplace and also working our level best to improve the working environment of each workplace for the women workers in the light of labor laws. He shared that we have drafted women workers' issues and shared with higher authorities for further legislation on a provincial level.

Deputy Director of the Social Welfare Department Mr. Abdul Samad shared that we

are in close coordination with all workplaces which are registered with us for the formation of anti-harassment committees, provision of the separate washroom, and other legal rights of women workers, most workplaces agreed on the formation of the anti-harassment committee, provision of minimum wages as per the government notification and we are also working on WWA members monitoring report to eliminate the issues of women workers in our level and we have also informed the provincial office to raise the issues of women workers at the provincial level for further legislations.

Additional Deputy Commissioner Pishin Mr. Ameen Ullah Nasar shared that I appreciated the efforts towards women empowerment women's play a very important role in our society we should empower them and give the opportunity that they come ahead and work shoulder by shoulder with men and play their role to contribute in the country economy. He shared that I appreciate Youth Organization which they form the women workers alliance group in the district Pishin which are very actively working for the empowerment and capacity building of women workers due to women workers alliance members we have re-active our government level anti-harassment committee and now this committee is very active and will work with close coordination with WWA. He shared that we are fully supporting Youth Organization ongoing programs, including the voter education and provision of women CNIC in district Pishin. This support will continue with WWA and Youth team. He said that the women population in Pakistan is half of the man we should increase space for them and our support will be available at any stage and we will make sure the proper monitoring of workplaces along with concern line

departments for providing a friendly atmosphere to women workers and I am also requesting to MNA to discuss the presented charter of demand in the national assembly as in provincial assembly through their party MPAs for further legislations and we strongly endorse the points of the charter of demand it should be implemented.



After the speech of ADC Pishin, the chief guest Muli Kamal Ud-Din Member of the National Assembly elected from district Pishin presented his speech. During his speech, he shared that today I am very happy that women from Pishin are talking about their legal rights in a very structured form as women workers alliance I agreed with all points which are presented in the charter of demand.

He shared that our religion Islam teaches us about the rights of women with very clarity but due to our society and cultural barrier we are not providing their rights as taught us. We should provide their rights in light of Islam and laws because women are very important pillars of the society they should contribute their part in the society. He emphasizes the labor department to make sure their monitoring visits all workplaces and make sure the legal rights of women workers, he

shared that it is very astonishing that women workers are demanding separate washrooms from owner it should be available in each workplace, anti-harassment committees should be formed that women can record their complaint through the proper channel without any fair. He also directed the district administration to play their role in the provision of a safe and protective environment to all women workers at workplaces. He promised that he will talk in the National Assembly on the charter of demand and also promised that his party MPAs will also talk in the provincial assembly on the presented charter of demand points and ensure us for their support at any level and also said that women workers alliance members can visit our office and share their issues with us I will talk their issues with concern department.

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
